UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

STUDIES IN NORDHAUSEN

You would like to pursue studies in Nordhausen, but your higher education entrance qualification is not recognized in Germany. No problem. If your graduation diploma qualifies you to enrol in institutions of higher learning in your home country, you can quickly prove your aptitude for your desired course of study by taking the university entrance examination. In passing that examination, you demonstrate that you meet the language, professional and methodological requirements for Bachelor's studies at the Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences. Once you have passed the examination, you can apply directly for a place in one of the study programmes we offer.

Admission Requirements

- Foreign higher education entrance qualification
- Command of German (Level B2)



Exams

The entrance examination is comprised of four written exams and an oral exam.

- Written exam (120 minutes)
German / English / mathematics
- Course-specific exam (120 minutes)
Engineering sciences – physics
Economics – macroeconomics
Social sciences – social studies
- Oral exam (15 to 30 minutes)
Technical communication



Registration for the Examination

Your application for admission to the entrance examination must be received at the Studien-Service-Zentrum of the Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences by 15 March of the year concerned.

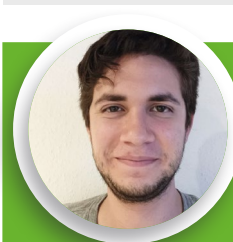


Fees
