Ethical challenges for social workers during the covid-19 pandemic.

Content:

The main aim of the course is to identify and discuss the ethical dilemmas that social workers face during the covid-19 pandemic. The second goal is to identify ethical solutions to the identified ethical problems.

Content:

- 1. Ethical Theories: Overview
- 2. Human rights how to protect them in the pandemic?
- 3. Social worker in the pandemic
- 4. How to create and maintain trusting, honest and empathic relationships via phone and internet with due regard to privacy and confidentiality, or in-person with protective equipment?
- 5. How to prioritise service user needs and demands, which are greater and different due to the pandemic, when resources are stretched or unavailable and full assessments often impossible?
- 6. How to balance service user rights, needs and risks against personal risk to social workers and others, in order to provide services as well as possible?
- 7. How to handle emotions, fatigue and the need for self-care, when working in unsafe and stressful circumstances?

Methods:

- 1. Introductory or summary mini-lectures
- 2. Case studies analysis|
- 3. Roleplay in simulated situations
- 4. Developing a project to solve ethical dilemmas in specific situations
- 5. Discussions and debates on ethical issues in the practice of a social worker in the pandemic era.
