Content:

Universal Human Rights are fundamental for Human Being. World should be a brotherhood. Equality and non-discrimination is essential to live together in peace. Everyone is entitled to a social and international order in which the rights and freedoms set forth in Universal Declaration of Human Rights can be fully realized. Everyone has duties to the community in which the free and full development of his personality is possible. The limitations come from the democratic law respecting the liberties of each other. These rights, duties and freedoms may in no case be exercised contrary to the purposes and principles of the United Nations.
